#### TAUBMANS paint by PPG named newest Nightingale Housing partner

Paint brand to deliver custom colour palettes, collaborate on architectural coatings solutions

MELBOURNE, Australia, March 30, 2021 – TAUBMANS® paint by PPG today announced an ongoing partnership with Nightingale Housing to harness the power of colour and explore new architectural coating innovations for the group's next generation of sustainable urban housing.

Led by Rachel Lacy, PPG colour category manager, architectural coatings, Australia and New Zealand, the *Taubmans* team is collaborating with the six Nightingale Housing architecture firms behind Nightingale Village. The team is developing custom colour palettes for each apartment building using the brand's new COLOURSMITH® tools and is also drawing on colour theory to enhance the comfort, functionality, durability and community connectedness of the apartment buildings.

"Like most architects, we shy away from colour sometimes," said Jeremy McLeod, founding director, Nightingale Housing and Breathe Architecture. "When we do choose colours, especially for something as important as a facade, we really think about it. Working with our partners at *Taubmans* paint on Nightingale projects makes that process engaging and inspiring."

Nightingale Housing apartments are built for owner-occupiers – not investors – and are based on the triple-bottom-line principles of environmentally, financially and socially sustainable design. The apartments are sold at the cost price via a ballot system that prioritises the affordable housing needs of applicants employed in community service roles, such as paramedics, police officers and teachers.

The buildings boast the highest-possible sustainability ratings, including minimum 7.5 star NatHERS thermal ratings. They use low carbon footprint materials, rainwater harvesting, communal laundries, vegetable gardens and shared cars.

"Very strong synergies exist between PPG and Nightingale Housing, which made the partnership a natural fit," said David Nicholls, PPG commercial director, Australia. "At PPG and under our *Taubmans* paint brand in Australia, we have long supported projects that offer widespread and sustained benefits to our communities, simply because it's the right thing to do. We also strive to solve our customers' greatest challenges by working with them to develop innovative coatings solutions."

Nicholls added, "We are committed to being part of the solution to Australia's affordable housing crisis and the environmental challenges facing us all as a global community. Through our partnership with Nightingale Housing, we will explore and test architectural coatings that are designed to reduce a building's carbon footprint and to mitigate the impacts of climate change."

In addition to the Nightingale Village projects, the *Taubmans* team is collaborating with Breathe Architecture on Nightingale Ballarat – the first regional Nightingale Housing project and the city's first carbon-neutral building. In homage to Ballarat's rich architectural heritage, the ground floor will consist of recycled red bricks and balconies on the Davey Street facade will be finished in the bespoke *Coloursmith* colour Ballarat Brick by Breathe Architecture.
